Subject: Summary Report of Activities for the Month of August, 1956

Work during the past month has been directed toward preparing the quarry and the exposed bones for the construction which will be soon initiated. The exploration of the area for the west foundation of the building is very nearly completed. The exposed bone west of the quarry shelter has been protected by an extra heavy coat of bur-lap and plaster in order to protect them from accidental damage during construction. The specimens and equipment within the quarry shelter have been organized so that they can be moved within a couple of days notice.
